We are seeking an energetic and motivated LCSW to design, implement, and supervise a youth therapy program with 2-3 graduate school interns. The launch of this new mental health initiative is in response to the growing mental health needs of youth in our community. In addition to supervision of interns, the Program Director will be part of the team that develops mental health supports, including prevention efforts (i.e. parent groups, adolescent support groups, school collaborations, etc.). The position allows for reduced hours in July and August.
